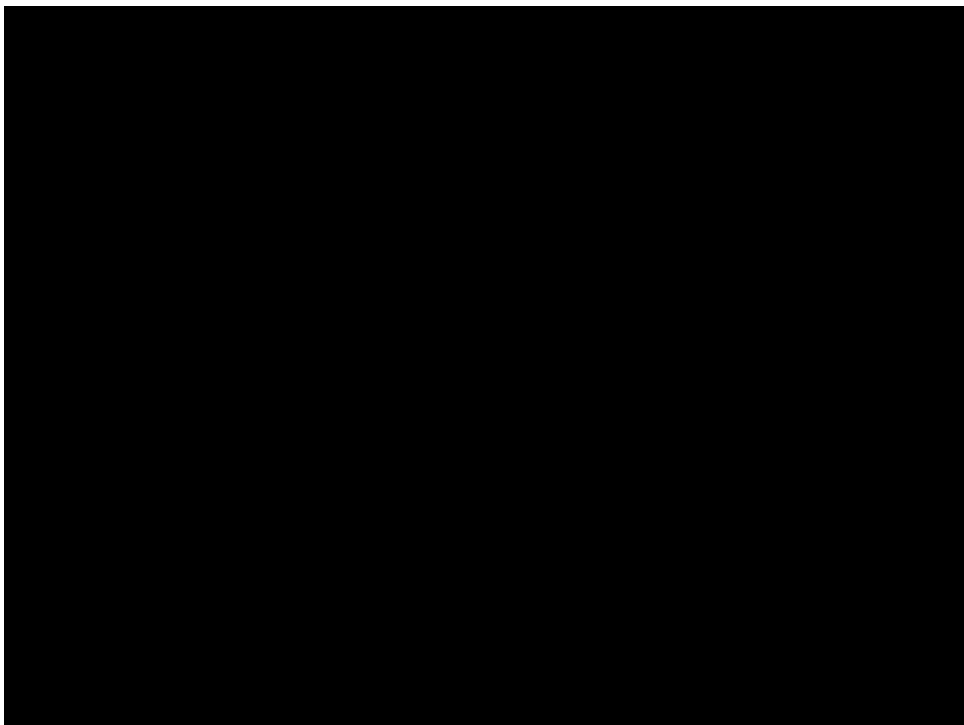

- The course content is not altered and is intended for adults;

- Parents must communicate with their son/daughter about academic progress and not with the instructor or other college personnel;
- Students should enroll in college-level coursework (courses numbered 1-99)
- No physical education courses may be taken.
