- **How long will I be doing distance learning?**
  - At this point in time, distance learning for YCUSD will continue through June 5, 2020.
  
- **Will the school year be extended?**
  - No, the school year will not be extended.
  
- **Will I have midterms? What will my 3rd quarter grade be?**
  - There will not be midterms. Your 3rd quarter grade will be based on your grade you had when we last attended school on Monday March 16 unless you have arrangements with your teachers to complete work thru 4/19. Report cards will be mailed as usual.
  
- **What grades will I receive for the rest of the year? How will it affect my GPA?**
  - Your grade for 4th quarter will be either a pass or a fail. This does not affect your GPA.

- **How will I be graded?**
  - Your grade for the 4th quarter will be based on engagement and participation with each classroom.
  
- **Will there be a graduation ceremony?**
  - Graduation is postponed not cancelled.
  
- **How do I know what time my classes meet online?**
  - If you have not heard from your teacher in google classroom please email your teacher.
  
- **How do I check course selections for next year?**
  - You may email your counselor about courses for next school year.
  
- **Will I have finals?**
  - Grades in the 4th quarter are being determined through engagement and classroom participation.
  
- **Will there be summer school?**
  - We will be offering summer school, but we are not sure the format that will be used.
  
- **Concerns about taking AP Exams and students expressing they won't cover all material/be prepared for the exam.**
