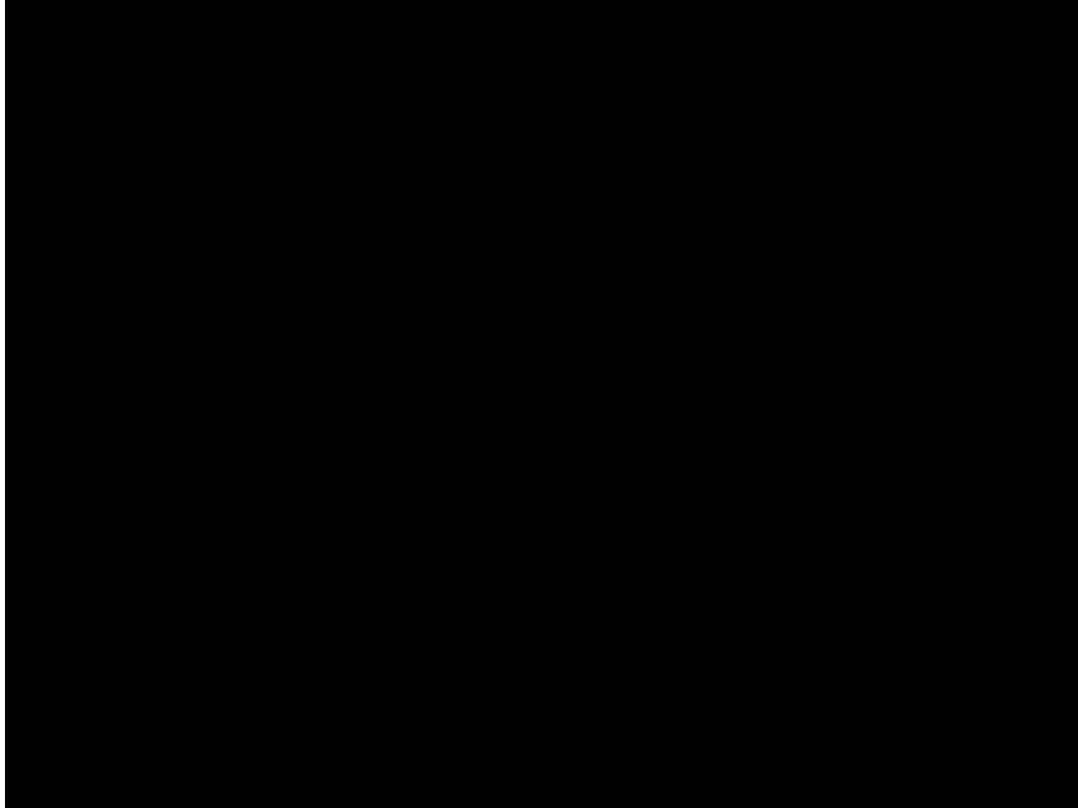

 - Do not rely on the credit summary box or graduation status box on Aeries.
Computer calculations can be misleading

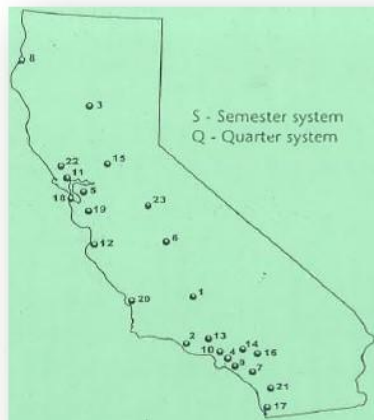

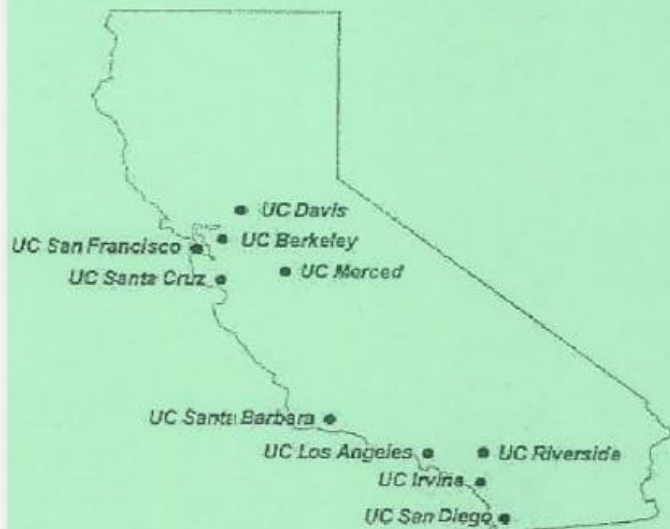

APPLYING FOR COLLEGE

- CSU/UC or Private College:
 - Complete A-G requirements (C or higher)
 - SAT and/or ACT
 - Apply: CSU (Oct 1 - Nov 30) & UC (Aug 1 - Nov 30)
 - EOP/EOP&S (Educational Opportunity Program)
 - NCAA (Search for NCAA Eligibility Center)

- Cal State Apply

- University of California

- Private Colleges/Universities



Program designed for low income/first generation college students. Provides supports including academic advising, summer program, tutoring, etc

COLLEGE ADMISSIONS TESTING

- Traditionally if you planned on applying to a 4 year university, you must have taken the SAT/ACT by December of your senior year
- **However** for the class of 2021, CSU/UCs realize not all students had the opportunity to take a test. Therefore, admissions will not use the SAT/ACT in reviewing applications for acceptance
- If you have taken the SAT/ACT, your scores may be used for college course placement
