 - Complete A-G requirements (C or higher)
 - SAT and/or ACT
 - Apply: CSU (Oct 1 Nov 30) & UC (Aug 1 Nov 30)
 - EOP/EOP&S (Educational Opportunity Program)
 - NCAA (Search for NCAA Eligibility Center)
- <u>Cal State Apply</u>
- University of California
- <u>Private Colleges/Universities</u>

Program designed for low income/first generation college students. Provides supports including academic advising, summer program, tutoring, etc

COLLEGE ADMISSIONS TESTING

- Traditionally if you planned on applying to a 4 year university, you must have taken the SAT/ACT by December of your senior year
- <u>However</u> for the class of 2021, CSU/UCs realize not all students had the opportunity to take a test. Therefore, admissions will not use the SAT/ACT in reviewing applications for acceptance
- If you have taken the SAT/ACT, your scores may be used for college course placement
