



AP/HONORS POLICY



River Valley High School 2021 – 2022 Advanced Placement (AP) & Honors Policy

River Valley High School supports any student who wants to accept the challenges of advanced classes. The opportunity to be in an Advanced Placement (AP) or Honors class carries a certain assumption about the capabilities and maturity of student who will be doing advanced or college level work.

- You understand that you have to demonstrate independence and responsibility for these advanced or college level courses.
- You understand that a failing grade in an Advanced Placement (AP) or Honors course may impact your graduation status.
- You understand that each Advanced Placement (AP) or Honors course may require as much as 1-2 hours of homework per night.
- You will read the course/teacher syllabus and will fulfill ALL of the course requirements.
- You understand that completion of summer work/winter work is required for students to be appropriately prepared for the course. **Students who have NOT COMPLETED the required summer/winter assignments will NOT be allowed to DROP the course.**
- You understand that you cannot transfer or drop an Advanced Placement (AP) or Honors class once May 14, 2021 has passed.

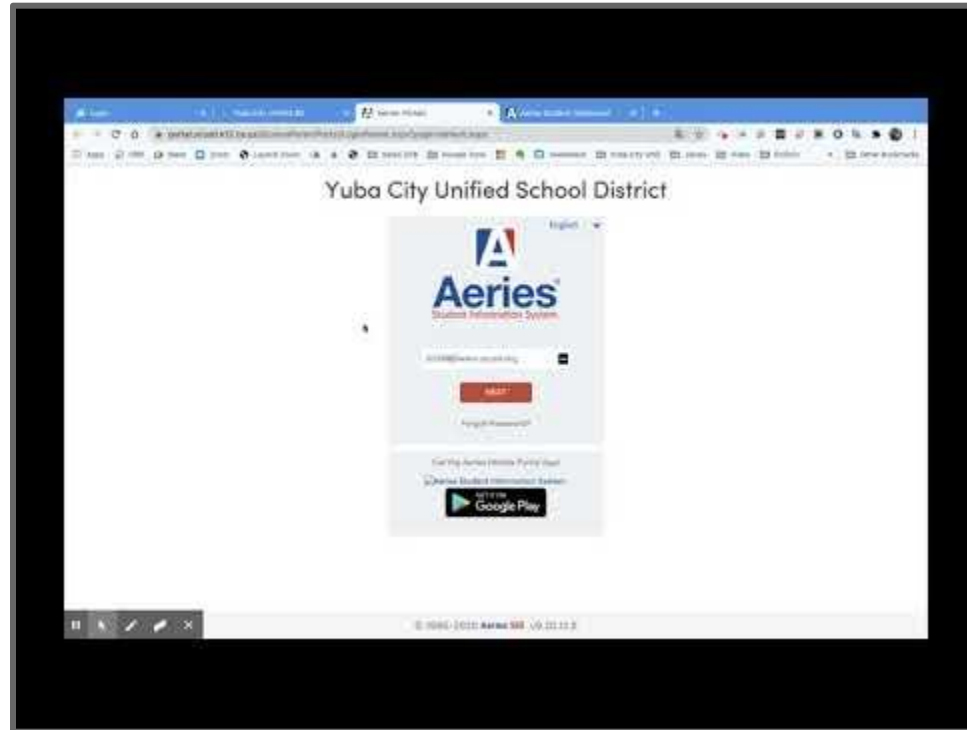
YUBA COLLEGE CLASSES

- If you plan to take Yuba College classes next year, you still need to select **8 classes and 4 alternates**.
- If you plan to take a Yuba College class to replace a graduation requirement, you **MUST** successfully complete it prior to the academic year you are scheduled for it.

REDUCED DAY

- **IF** you are a junior or senior, and interested in a reduced day you must meet the following requirements:
 - On track for graduation
 - Maintain a 3.0 or higher GPA
 - Completing A-G **and** completing a CTE Pathway
 - Satisfactory attendance and disciplinary record
 - Proof of enrollment in work experience or Yuba College classes
